Report issues or problems of concern to governance to FacEx, with due regard for the confidentiality of individual cases (ongoing).

FY2017 FRB:

The Faculty Rights Board received three appeals in FY2017. The appeals were based on alleged procedural violations. FRB did not receive any appeals regarding Promotion and Tenure or Non-Reappointment.

1. Be prepared to revisit policies and procedures for faculty dismissal proceedings (formerly proposed FSRR 7.3.4) and related issues.
